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Vaccine Schedule Variance Plan

We firmly believe in the effectiveness of vaccines to prevent serious illness and to save lives. We firmly believe that vaccinating children and young adults may be the single most important health-promoting intervention we perform as health care providers, and that you can perform as parents/caregivers. We firmly believe in the safety of our vaccines.

We firmly believe that all children and young adults should receive all of the recommended vaccines according to the schedule published by the Centers for Disease Control and the American Academy of Pediatrics. It is NC law that all children be vaccinated; records are reviewed upon entry to daycare and formal school.

We firmly believe, based on all available literature, that vaccines do not cause autism or other developmental disabilities. While some children have mild side effects with vaccines, we monitor carefully for any new reports of adverse effects of our vaccine products.

Delays in the recommended vaccine schedule may put your child at unnecessary risk for life-threatening illness and disability, and even death. Deviation from the schedule can also create errors in dosing at unfamiliar intervals.

North Raleigh Pediatrics will allow a waiver with the following requirements:

- Primary series DTaP, IPV, HIB, Prevnar (0-6mos vaccines) finished by 9 months.
- MMR/Varicella/Hepatitis B by 2 years.
- Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines prior to 7th grade (age 10-12).

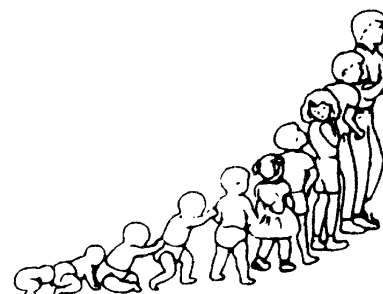
